2.6 - STUDENT PERFORMANCE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES

2.6.1 - TEACHERS AND STUDENTS ARE AWARE OF THE STATED PROGRAMME AND COURSE OUTCOMES OF THE PROGRAMMES OFFERED BY THE INSTITUTION.

The Gargaon College follows the syllabus prescribed by Dibrugarh University. But the Programme and Course Outcomes are not provided in the syllabus. Therefore, the faculty members of each Department prepared their own Programmes and Course Outcomes based on the prescribed syllabus. Both the Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and Course Outcomes (COs) have been made available in the college website to facilitate those who are interested in knowing about the details of the programme available in Gargaon College. The syllabus for the programmes along with PSOs and Cos has been made available in the webpage of each department. The candidates seeking admission in Gargaon College can view the programme specific outcomes of each department in the college website which facilitates them in selecting the programme of their own choice. The print version of the syllabus with the Course Outcomes is also available in the respective departments and in Principal's office for ready reference for the teachers and students.

The Course Outcomes (COs) and Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) were formulated according to the decision of Academic Development Committee, Governing Body and Internal Semester Monitoring Committee of the college after a detailed discussion in the meeting. The Course Outcomes (COs) and Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) are again modified according to the changes in the syllabus and then again communicated to the students.

At the beginning of each academic session, the students were oriented about the Course and Programme Outcomes by the Principal and faculty members of the college. In order to make the students motivated towards the course, the importance and relevance of the course were also discussed with the students by the faculty members of the respective departments. The students were also made aware about the job opportunities available for them after completing a particular programme. More over Gargaon College have 'Career Counselling and Guidance Cell' which organizes interactive session with the student to orient them about the various courses, career options available for them so that they can establish linkages with the world of work and locate career opportunities

2.6.2 ATTAINMENT OF PROGRAMME OUTCOMES, PROGRAMME SPECIFIC OUTCOMES AND COURSE OUTCOMES ARE EVALUATED BY THE INSTITUTIONS

Students' attainment of Programme Outcomes and Course Outcomes is measured on the basis of student's performances in continuous internal assessment and final examinations. The direct evaluation tools for the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) consists of two written tests for 40 marks. The Continuous evaluations of the students are also done through class tests, remedial classes, submission of assignment, presentation of seminar paper, preparation of project report and involvement of the student in laboratory work. The distributions of marks are set as per the instructions of the University. Besides Internal Assessment, There is a summative final Examination to evaluate the academic attainments of the students at the completion of each semester.

The learning outcomes of the respective programmes are also achieved through student's involvement in various extension activities and their participation in co-curricular activities. Students' performance in all these activities are evaluated by the faculty members to assure that the learning outcomes are achieved both in curricular and co-curricular activities recognized by the College.

`After continuous internal assessment and final examinations, Dibrugarh University declares the results of students' performance in each course of the college. The governing body and academic Development Council of the college analyses the pass percentage and evaluates the performances of the students in each programme. These bodies give suggestions for further improvement and assurance of achievement of the course outcome, programme specific outcomes and programme outcome.

The IQAC of Gargaon College conducts student satisfactory survey on a regular basis to evaluate the overall development of the college including programme outcome. Each departments of the college hold Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM), Mentor –Mentee Meeting (MMM) from time to time to obtain feedback and suggestions for overall development of students. Attainment of outcomes is also evaluated through feedback



from college alumni. Productive analysis of the course outcome and programme specific outcomes of the institution is conducted on the basis of feedback from students, Parents and Alumni. Students Progress to higher education and profile of alumni of the college indicates the attainment of COs/Pos of the college.

The IQAC of Gargaon College conducted an online student satisfactory survey of students from different departments for the session 2020-2021. The analysis of survey report shows that More than fifty percent of the student strongly agreed with the statement that Gargaon College provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow (53.5%) and the college also takes active interest regularly in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities for students (56.3%). The teaching and mentoring process in Gargaon College significantly facilitates the students in their cognitive, social and emotional growth (47.5%). Efforts are made by the teachers of Gargaon College to a great extent to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make the student ready for the getting employment (64.9%).

IQAC Gargaon College also collected feedback from 585 alumni for the session 2020-2021. The analysis of Alumni Feedback Summary Report indicates that the Courses of Gargaon College are relevant to times (60%) and Gargaon College is providing excellent services in developing skills among the students required for employment (52%) and also for progressing towards higher studies (55%).

In this academic session of 2020-2021, all the above mentioned programmes and activities were conducted online through the exam Committee, Departments and various committees of the College.
