Objective of the Program: To help students know about the ecological and taxonomic study of that area.

Brief report of the program

As a part of syllabus, a one-day field trip to Dibru- Saikhowa National Park was organized by the Department. On 19th December, 2021 B.Sc. 1st, 3rd and 5th Semester students visited Dibru Saikhowa National Park along with two faculty members, Dr. Dimbeshwar Das and Miss Sandeepa Agarwalla. The team arrived the location at around 10 am.

During the visit four forest guards accompanied the team and provided some valuable information regarding the park. Dibru-saikhowa National park covers an area of 650 sq.km, and is located close to the eastern boarder of Assam, between Dibrugarh district and Tinsukia district. It was declared National Park in the year 1999. It is bounded by the Brahmaputra river, Lohit river and Arunachal hills in the North and Dibru river, Debang river and Dibru and Patkai Hills in the South.

The forest type of Dibru Saikhowa comprises of semi-evergreen forests, deciduous forests, littoral, swamp forests, and patches of wet evergreen forests. A total of 36 species of mammals, and over 400 species of birds have been recorded so far. Dibru Saikhowa National Park is ideal for a gigantic tree called as “Kekjouri Tree” that occupies an entire island. It has amazing maze of roots and branches spiralling all around and is about 120 years old. So, the location was a good choice for ecological and taxonomic study for the students.



Rationality of the program:

The outreach programs helped the students to know about the ecological, taxonomic and also the biological diversity of the area. Dibru Saikhowa National Park is ideal for a gigantic tree called as “Kekjouri Tree” that occupies an entire island the students were therefore able to observe and know about its history.
