Brief Description and Rationale of the Program

The Career Counselling and Guidance Cell at Gargaon College organized a workshop on "Preparation for Joining Armed Forces" on 28th April 2022. The workshop aimed to provide guidance and information to aspiring candidates who aspire to join the Indian Army as officers in various ranks. The event was attended by 211 enthusiastic students.

The workshop featured two distinguished resource persons, Major Jonah Halam and Captain Bibhas Biswas from the 12 Assam Rifles. Both speakers shared their valuable insights and experiences regarding the preparation for the Combined Defence Services (CDS) and Short Service Commission (SSC) examinations.

Major Jonah Halam commenced the workshop by emphasizing the importance of physical and mental preparation for the rigorous selection process. He encouraged the students to adopt a disciplined lifestyle, including regular exercise, healthy eating habits, and proper sleep patterns. Captain Bibhas Biswas actively interacted with the students, forming small groups to address their individual queries and concerns. He shared personal anecdotes and provided guidance on the overall selection process, including the written examination, personal interview, and physical fitness assessment. Captain Bibhas stressed the significance of comprehensive preparation, including familiarity with current affairs, general knowledge, and the ability to think critically under pressure.

The workshop proved to be immensely beneficial for the participants. It provided them with valuable insights into the various aspects of joining the armed forces as officers. The guidance provided by Major Jonah Halam and Captain Bibhas Biswas equipped the students with a roadmap for their future preparations.
