As a part of syllabus, a botanical excursion trip to Manas National Park was organized by the department for B.Sc. 2nd, 4th and 6th Semester students. On 30th April the journey started and ended on 3rd April, 2022. Two faculties Dr. Dimbeshwar Das and Miss Sandeepa Agarwalla accompanied the students in the excursion.

The journey started from Simaluguri junction and ended at Manas National Park. Everything was planned beforehand for fooding and lodging. The stay for the journey was at Smiling Tusker Elephant camp at Manas. The students also got to interact with Miss Ivy Farheen Hussain, a project officer of Tiger Research and Conservation Division of an NGO-ARANYAK. She gave an informative talk on 'Reducing the number of wildlife animal abuses."

Manas National Park is an abode of many species of plants, animals and birds. They are scattered in the entire area. Besides the rich floral vegetation, an ecotone was also visible. A total of 543 plants have been documented from the core of Manas. The forest is also rich in faunal diversity. The students had a wonderful experience throughout the journey.
