OVERVIEW OF THE PROGRAM

IQAC of Gargaon College in collaboration with Gargaon College Science Forum has organized a one-day workshop on vermicompost for green livelihood. The main aim of the program was to teach student about different aspect of vermicompost. Dr. Dimbeswar Das, Assistant Professor of Botany Department highlighted that vermicompost is the product of earthworm digestion and aerobic decomposition



using the activities of micro- and microorganisms at room temperature. Vermicomposting, or worm composting, produces a rich organic soil amendment containing a diversity of plant nutrients and beneficial microorganisms. He also emphasized the importance such small business for self-employment.
