ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

As part of its initiative to observe World Environment Day, Gargaon College carried out a series of programmes on 5th June under the aegis of Gargaon College Science Forum in collaboration with IQAC, Environment & Climate Cell, NSS Unit, Eco-Club, 11 Assam Girls' (I) NCC Coy & 49 Assam Naval Unit, Gargaon College and Assam Science Society, Gargaon Branch, Sivasagar. The celebration began with the flag hoisting by the President of Gargaon College Science Forum, Dr. Dilip Kumar Deka followed by a plantation drive in the college campus. Present on this occasion were the Vice Principal, Dr. Rina Handique, Dr. Kabita Phukon, Secretary of the forum, college staff, NSS and NCC volunteers of the college. Significantly, the celebrations also marked the 12th foundation day of Gargaon College Science Forum. An Elocution Competition on the themes "Beat Plastic Pollution, Global Warming, Bio-Diversity & Green India Clean India" was held during the later half of the day. The event moderated by Dr. Dilip Kumar Deka was inaugurated by noted academician, columnist, and Principal of Gargaon College, Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta. In his address, Dr. Mahanta spoke on the significance of the World Environment Day which was led by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and has been held annually on 5 June since 1973. Dr. Anna Gogoi, Dr.Dimbeshwar Das and Dr. Bidyut Bikash Hazarika, faculty members of Gargaon College acted as the judges of the competition. The first prize was bagged by Arpana Sonowal of the Department of Geology, the second prize went to Tamanna Sultana of the Department of Botany and the third prize was won by Munmun Gogoi of the department of Assamese. In the evening, a webinar on the theme "Solutions to Plastic Pollution" was also held to mark the occasion. Dr. Saheen Shehnaz Begum, Assistant Professor of the department of Chemistry moderated the programme while Dr. Dilip Kumar Deka, Associate Professor of the department of Geography gave the welcome address. While inaugurating the webinar, Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, eminent columnist, academician and Principal of Gargaon College spoke on the need to strike a balance between development and conservation of the environment. He expressed concern over the reckless tendency to use plastic in our day to day lives despite the growing hazards created to environment and living creatures by plastic pollution. In order to mitigate such hazards, he stressed upon the need to take effective and proactive measures instead of delimiting oneself to the mere practice of preaching. The resource person Dr. Nirmali Gogoi, Associate Professor of the Department of Environmental Science, Tezpur University spoke elaborately on the topic "Plastic Pollution: From Awareness to Action." She explained different facets of the topic such as the lifecycle of plastic pollution, effects of burning and burying plastic, microplastics and their potential health risks, alternatives measures and solutions to tackle plastic pollution, government's initiatives to tackle the same etc.
