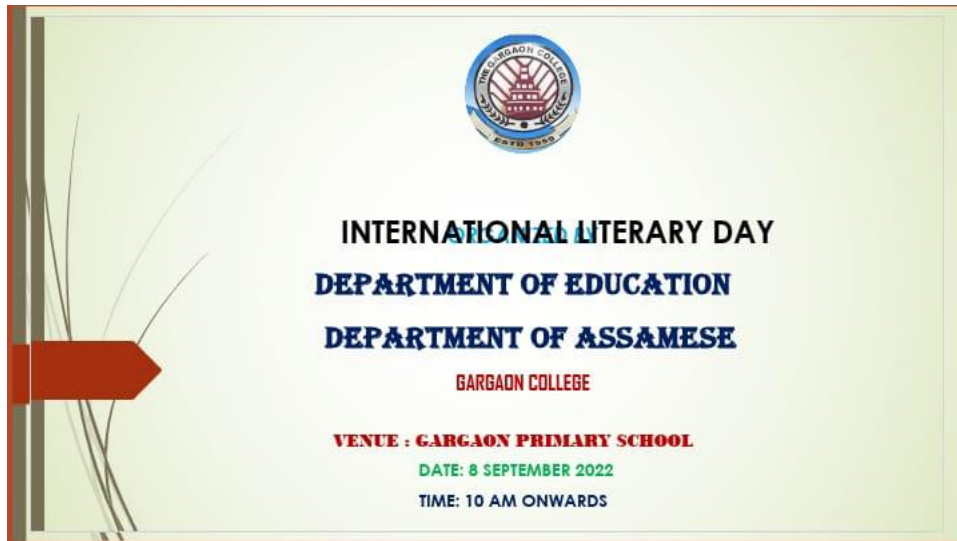

As per data shared by UNESCO around 775 million people around the world are deprived of basic literacy skill. The data says that one in five adults remain illiterate. The data also reflects vast gender gap between male and females. International Literacy Day serves as an opportunity for international organizations and government to work for promoting literacy.
