Objective of the Program: Monthly financial assistance to the eligible beneficiaries by Government of Assam

Brief report of the program

'Orunodoi' or Arunodoi Scheme, is a scheme of the Government of Assam, launched on 2nd October 2020. Under 'Orunodoi', monetary benefits have been envisaged for more than 24 lac poor household in the state. It is described as 'foremost bread' among the *Ashtadash Mukutar Unnoyonee Maala*. The scheme envisages poverty eradication and socio-economic inclusion of financially vulnerable families of the state through sustained financial assistance by DBT, leveraging cash transfer of minimum monthly cash flow. The other objective is to minimise multiplicity of schemes and consolidate them through the DBT platform in aid of better delivery and outcomes.

37 NSS Volunteers of NSS Unit Gargaon College participated in the training programme for VT members for 'Orunodoi Month' at Sibsagar Girl's College. All these volunteers worked as VT member in various Gaon Panchayats of Sivasagar District.

Rationality of the program:

It is an ambitious and momentous step towards socio-economic empowerment to empower women of the state and to provide financial support to the economically vulnerable families.

2) Cleanliness and Plantation Drive

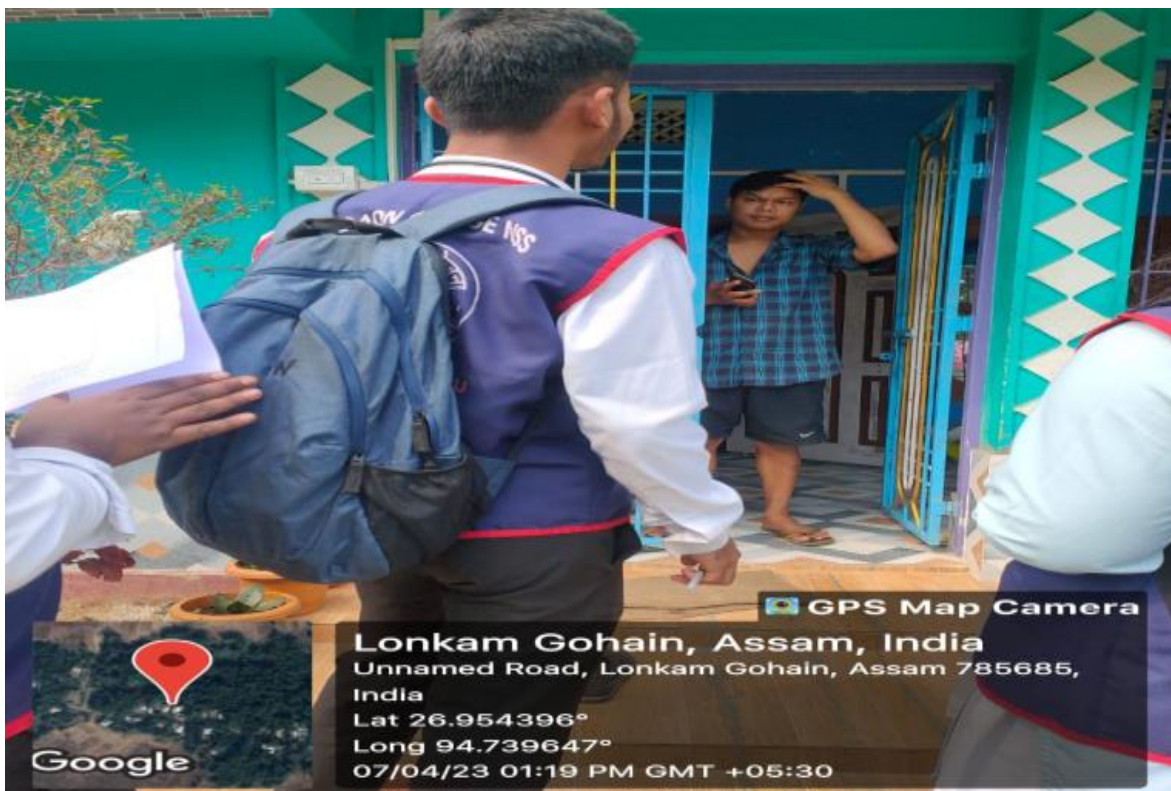
