Significance of the Day:

World Aids Day is observed every year on 1st December since 1988 to raising awareness of the Aids pandemic which is caused by HIV infection. It is an International Day dedicated and mourning those who have died of this disease.

About the program/Details of the Program:

The Gargaon College NSS Unit in collaboration with Eco Club and IQAC organized World AIDS Day on 1st December, 2022. The awareness programme conducted by the NSS Unit of the college aimed at making the people aware of causes, symptoms, treatment and prevention of AIDS. The programme was held on the theme 'Equalize' given by the World Health Organization for this year, 2022. The programme was moderated by Dr. Rimjim Borah, NSS Programme Officer and Assistant Professor of Economics Department, Gargaon College. Mr. Diganta Konwar, Associate Professor of Physics Department and Dr. Chirantan Bhagawati, Assistant Professor of Geology Department, Gargaon College acted as resource persons and delivered informative talks related to the theme. Firstly, Dr. Chirantan Bhagawati delivered a brief talk on Impact of Climate Change on Socio-Economic Conditions and its Influence on Emergence of HIV AIDS. In his deliberation, Dr. Bhagawati highlighted on the importance of the celebration of World AIDS Day following the theme of this year which is 'Equalize'. He also spoke on the effect of the disease which has taken unprecedented number of lives and call for an increased response to speak out against HIV stigma. Climate change has worked as an important factor in affecting the disease, Dr. Bhagawati said. He also stressed on to create awareness among people to equalize from socio-economic perspective.



The next speaker, Mr. Diganta Konwar delivered a speech on 'A Holistic Approach to Healthy Living'. He spoke on the five dimensions of holistic health mainly Physical, Intellectual, Emotional, Social and Spiritual which are key to holistic approach to healthy living. He also spoke on the health benefit to mindfulness as well as mindfulness techniques. Addressing the five dimensions of wellness, he said, builds a holistic sense of wellness and fulfillment in our lives. Mr. Konwar concluded his speech by mentioning about the consequences of stress. Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, Principal of Gargaon College lauded the efforts of the NSS Unit of the college for organizing such an awareness programme and familiarizing the students about AIDs and its hazadarous effect. Dr. Rimjim Borah offered vote of thanks at the end of the programme.
