



REPORT ON DEBATING AND ALLIED AFFAIRS

2022-2023











Brief description

The Annual College Week is a much-awaited event at Gargaon College, bringing together students from various departments to showcase their talents and compete in a friendly yet competitive atmosphere. This year's College Week was no exception, featuring a diverse range of competitions, including the Quiz Competition, Debate Competition, Speech Competition and Extempore Speech Competition.

Quiz Competition:

The College Week kicked off with the Quiz Competition, which was a test of knowledge, wit, and quick thinking. Teams from different departments participated, answering questions on a wide array of topics. The competition was intense, and the winning team demonstrated exceptional teamwork and general knowledge.

A total of **26 teams** participated in the event. Out of these, six teams made it to the final round, and three teams were declared winners. **Bastob Borbourah** and **Barnabh Ranjan Mahanta** of the **Geology Department** won the first prize. **Kaustavmoni Bhuyan** and **Durloavjyoti Bailung** of the **Geology department** clinched the second prize, and **Kankan Bezbaruah** and **Deeponwita Borpatragohain** of the **English Department** bagged the third prize.



Debate Competition:

The Debate Competition encouraged students to articulate their thoughts and opinions on thought-provoking topics. The participants engaged in lively discussions, demonstrating their ability to communicate persuasively and think critically. The event highlighted the importance of constructive discourse and effective argumentation.

The topic of the debate for the competitors was "In the Opinion of the House, Assam's traditional education system is responsible for Assamese youths' disheartening performance in the UPSC examinations." Ankur Gogoi (Zoology Department) was adjudged the best debator of the event, whereas Aparajita Baruah (Zoology Department) and Apurba Saikia (Sociology Department) won second and third prizes, respectively.

Speech Competition:

The Speech Competition provided a platform for students to showcase their oratory skills and address issues that matter to them. Speeches ranged from inspiring personal stories to thought-provoking discussions on societal challenges. The event offered a glimpse into our students' diverse perspectives and talents.

The topic of the speech competition was "**Digital education and modern Assam**". **Masumee Saikia** of the English Department won the first prize, **Aparajita Boruah** of the Zoology Department got the second prize, and the third prize was shared by **Mrinmoyee Gogoi** (English Department) and Ankur Gogoi (Zoology).



Extempore Speech Competition:

The Extempore Speech Competition was a unique test of spontaneous speaking abilities. Participants were given impromptu topics and had a limited time to prepare and deliver their speeches. It showcased the participants' ability to think on their feet and communicate effectively in unexpected situations. **Kalpajyoti Konwar** of the Chemistry Department got the first prize, **Ankita Gogoi** of the Assamese Department received the second prize, and **Deeponwita Borpatragohain** and **Masumee Saikia** of the English Department got the third prize jointly.
