Overview

Introduction:

Classroom in India (whether in a school or college) is typically a mixture of varied ability groups of students. It is due to their varied socio-cultural and techno-economic backgrounds. They basically differ from one another in terms of cognitive development and therefore their capacity to grasp domain knowledge and to evaluate critically is bound to differ. Their ability to articulate their understanding of the subject also differs. Curriculum transaction to such mixed group of students in one classroom is not possible since one approach does not work well to the satisfaction of all the students in the class. Categorization of students as advanced learners, average learners or slow learners in a class required to plan different strategies for curricular transaction and to provide support for meaningful learning experiences.

Who are Slow Learners: -

A slow learner is a student of below average intelligence who's thinking skills and scholastic performance have developed significantly slow than the pace of his/her age. Slow learners' learning pace is slower than their peers. Slow learners are neither rare nor unique. They cannot learn at an average rate form the instructional resource, texts, work look and learning materials designed for the majority of the students of the same age.

Strategies for Weak Student / Slow Learner Identification: -

Following key points are considered to identify the slow learner and fast learner.

- 1. By asking oral question in the classroom.
- 2. Conducting entry 'Behavior Test' based on the particular subject.
- 3. Performance based on 'Surprised Test.'
- 4. Marks obtained in the 'class unit test.'
- 5. To check their home assignment.
- 6. As per previous University/Board Results.

If the assessmen t marks <50% they are categorize d as slow learner

REMEDIAL CLASS


This is an alternate approach for the regular classroom teacher in instructing the slow learners. Remedial teaching is the use of activities, techniques and practices to eliminate weakness or deficiencies the slow learners is known to have. Deficiency in basic statistical skills can be reduced or eliminated by re-teaching the constant that was not learned earlier. The instructional environment does not change, as in the company approach. Conventional instructional technique such as repeated practice is employed.

Remedial classes focus on basic concepts developed better study habits (preparing notes etc) and to develop confidence in the students for respective subjects. Remedial classes help students to close the gap between what a student to close the gap between what a student knows and what he is expected to know.




