### **ABOUT THE PROGRAMME:**

Mentors are student centric teachers, guides who help the young learners in their academic and overall development. Mentors will ensure that all learners receive the care, guidance and support necessary to maintain and extend their personal development and academic progress.

## **ROLE AND RESPONBILITIES OF MENTOR:**

- Introduce and discuss the concept of Mentor-Mentee system with the assigned mentees.
- To take the lead in a one-on-one mentoring relationship with a mentee.
- To develop a trusting relationship with a mentee by showing concern and planning for the mentee's well-being.
- To serve as a role model for others.
- Respect for one another and be a good listener. Foster an atmosphere of trust.
- Maintain a record of the progress of the students and take necessary actions whenever required.
- Mentor should keep track of mentees attendance, academic performance and career development and maintain the data accordingly.

- Mentor should intimate the parents about the student attendance and academic performance regularly.
- Mentor should check the attendance of mentees, if anybody's attendance is below the requirement then he should find out the problem and take necessary actions to reform and the same should be communicated to the parents and HOD.
- Mentor should identify talents (sports, cultural, mooting, innovation, interests) of their students and encourage them to organize and participate in the events.
- Mentor should support mentees academically and emotionally.
- Mentor should ensure that their mentees are following instructions given by college.
- Establish a regular communication schedule and the means of communications (texting, phone calls, etc.)

## **ROLE AND RESPONBILITIES OF MENTEE:**

- Attend meeting regularly.
- Fill the form to give personal details at time of joining in the mentor-mentee system.
- Repose confidence in the mentor and seek his/her advice whenever required.
- Should have a work plan.
- Work on self without the Mentor.
- Be mindful to use your time effectively.
- Should be open and honest.
- Keep your Mentor updated on your personal/academic progress, contact Mentor as needed for support/or guidance.
- Create a list of 3 goals for the academic year. One goal should be an academic goal, one should be an extracurricular goal, and one should be a personal goal.

## **GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED BY MENTORS:**

- Student shall be assigned Mentor (Teaching Faculty/Alumni).
- Mentor shall have a minimum of 35 mentees
- Mentees should be attached to the same mentor for the duration of program if possible.
- Mentor should meet the mentees whenever necessary and update mentees' data sheet
- Mentor should keep track the mentees' academic performance, attendance and participation in competition, co-circular and extra circular actives.
- Mentor should identify the advance learners based on the academic performance and advise them to organize and participate in various clubs, committees and skill development programs.
- Mentor should identify the slow learners and advise them to attend remedial and make-up classes.
- Mentor should give psychosocial support to the mentees.
- Mentor also should identify the strengths and weakness of the students and motivate them to achieve the goals.

- It motivates and inspires pupils, as well as improving the morale of the learning community.

## <u>Highpoints</u>

The Mentor – Mentee Cell of the Department has alloted me 32 mentees in the academic year 2022 - 2023. As per the program of the "Mentor – Mentee Cell" counselling and interaction with the mentees were succesfully done for the academic year 2022 - 23.

Mentoring sessions were planned to motivate the mentees positively, to believe in their potential, do their best and adapt to the changing circumstances. 



### Name of the Mentor: Mrs. Sangeeta Chetia

A total of 31 students from 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> semester were alloted to me as Mentees for the Odd semester, 2022. 



- Previous exam records were collected and were suggested to study and take help from good performers.
- I suggested them to increase time of study along with the decline in the use of mobile phones. Healthy eating was also suggested to concentrate more on studies.
- Instead of only oral study they were suggested to practice writing more to help them increase their speed and proficiency.
- Interested students were informed and helped to fill-up forms of GATE, IIT-JAM, APRO, etc. I also guided them about the exam pattern.
