



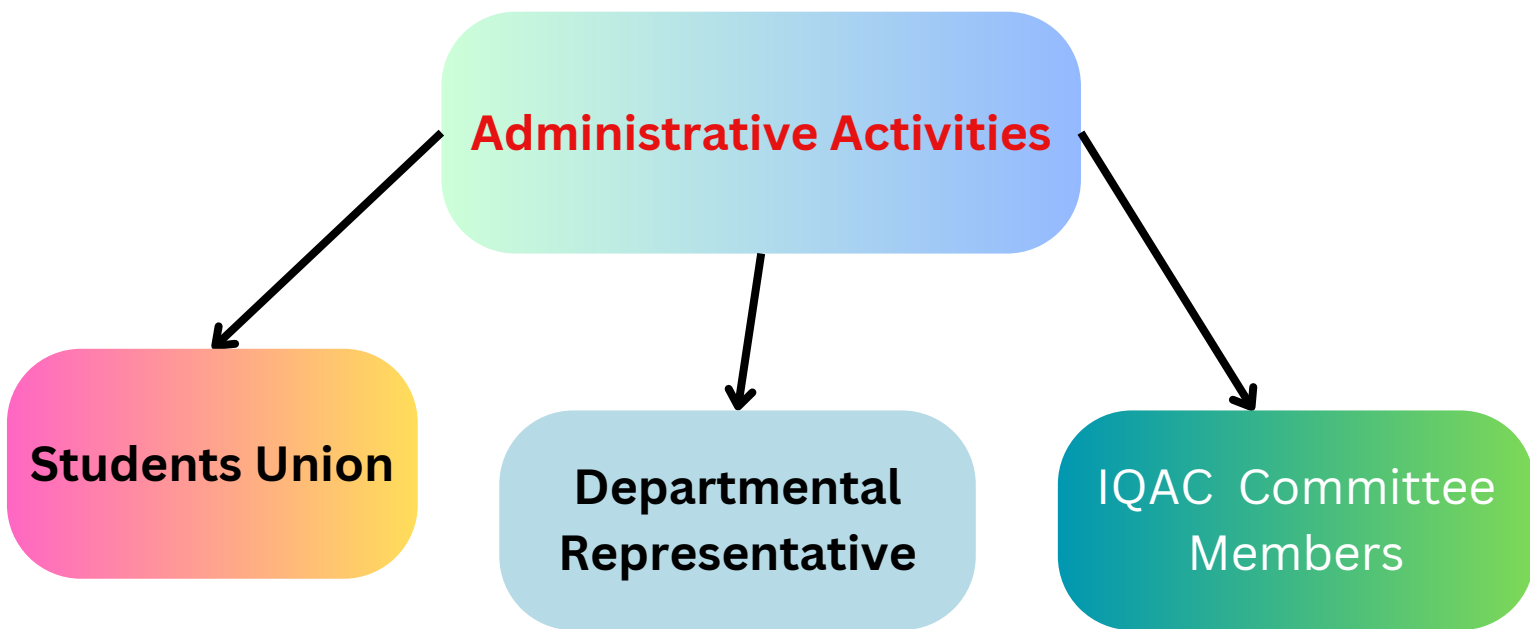
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**STUDENTS' REPRESENTATION AND ENGAGEMENT IN

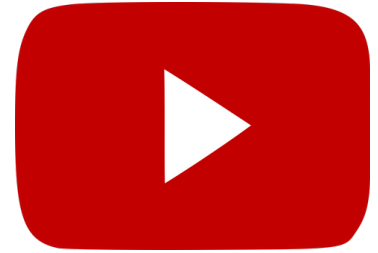



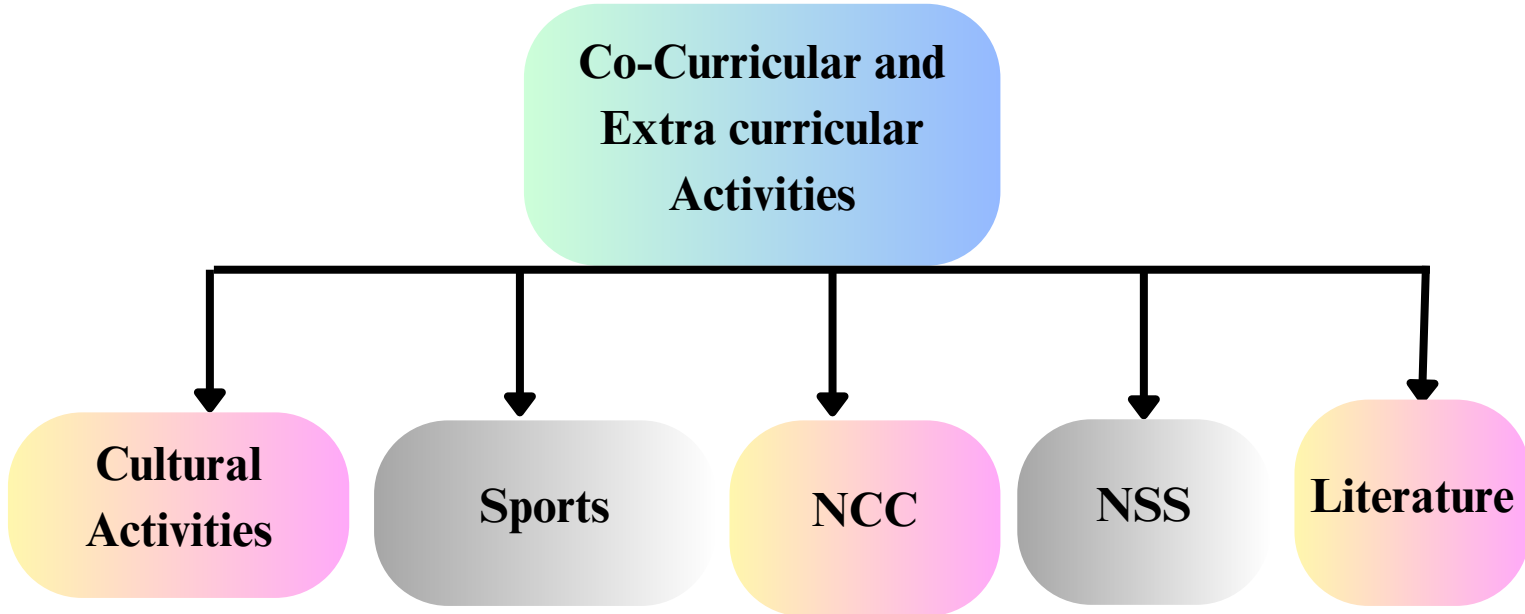
Co-Curricular Activities:

During college week the students actively participated in different games and sports events like football, cricket, volleyball, race, etc



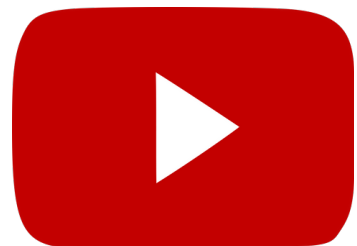


Student's participation in music competition

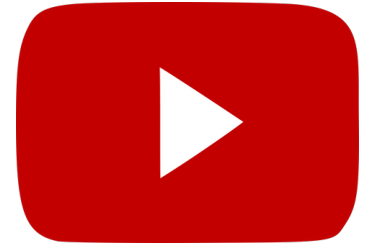
Student's participation in Debate and Allied Affairs
