Rationality of the programme

What spirituality signifies is knowledge in relation with soul or Brahma. In other words, it is associated with meditation upon the universal soul. The state of spiritual enlightenment is spirituality. Unveiling the mysteries behind the origin of life and the world, the ancient sages laid down their wisdom in great books. Travelling in simple and complex ways the trend of Indian spirituality wears a diverse look, but due to the prevailing character of harmony and unity it has developed into an all-inclusive one theory. This is what is known as knowledge of God as stated in Upanishad.

Indian spiritualism is philosophy-based. The meaning of this philosophy is to gain keen insight of things. When a man reaches the summit of knowledge he understands the precious truths of life. The exact relation between the Creator and His creations is identity in multiplicity. Spiritual mentality in that way can show one the path of truthful and perfect ways of life.

It is mentioned in Sandogya Upanishad that religious austerity, charity, simplicity, non-violence and truthfulness are the modes of worships of life (3/17/4). These are the fundamentals of spirituality. Spirituality has its own principles. At the keen perceptions of these thoughts in Upanishad it is observed that sacrifice and composure eared from the society and nature helps one achieve power. It does not, however, empower one to develop a mentality to establish authority upon the society.

The power inherent in religion is not identical with outward appearance. Today, flamboyance is prevailing over spiritualism as inherent in religion. A coordination of the body, the mind, the heart and the soul, i.e. a spiritual feeling can pave the way for a change in the society.


