Rationality of the program

The peer teaching-learning process is very essential for students of slow learner category. It proves beneficial to both the learner-student and the teacher-student. The slow learner is able to grasp well when explained by a peer, and the advanced learner's knowledge increases through revision of the topic before imparting it to the peer. Such a direct interaction between students promotes active learning as well as participation within themselves. Student's teachers enhance their own depth of knowledge in the topic by instructing others. Advanced learners are usually chosen to head these teaching sessions with support from the teacher as and when necessary.

Brief report of the program

Department of Zoology, Gargaon College conducted peer teaching methodology for slow learner for improvement of their learning processes. In peer teaching the teachers of the Department assign a particular topic to a selected student from advanced learner category. The topic is given in advance so that the student can prepare well for the class. It is mostly a repetition of topics taken in class. The student plays the role of a teacher and takes the class, understanding the mindset of the class. Students also imbibe better ideas from a peer.

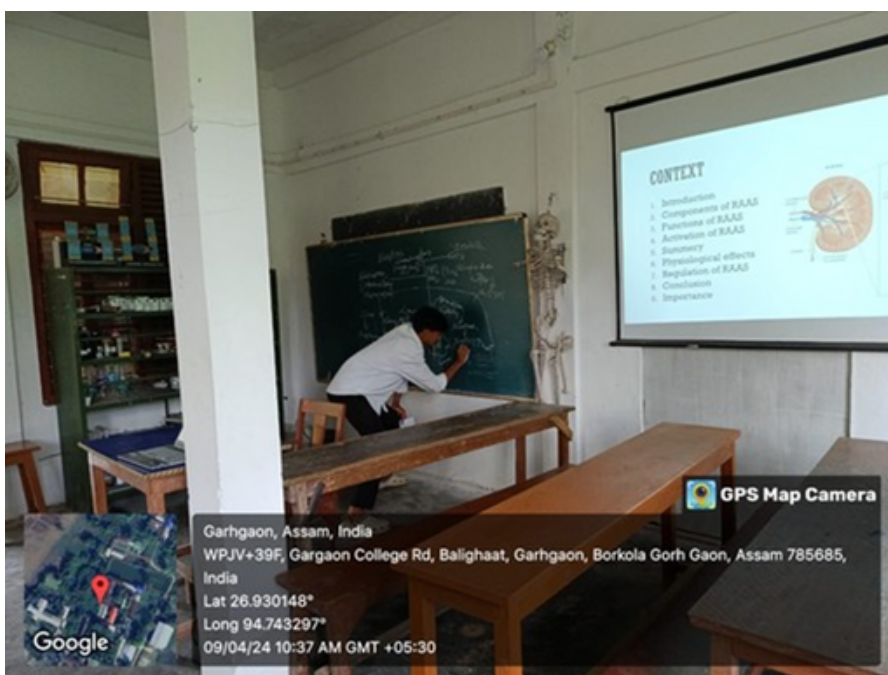

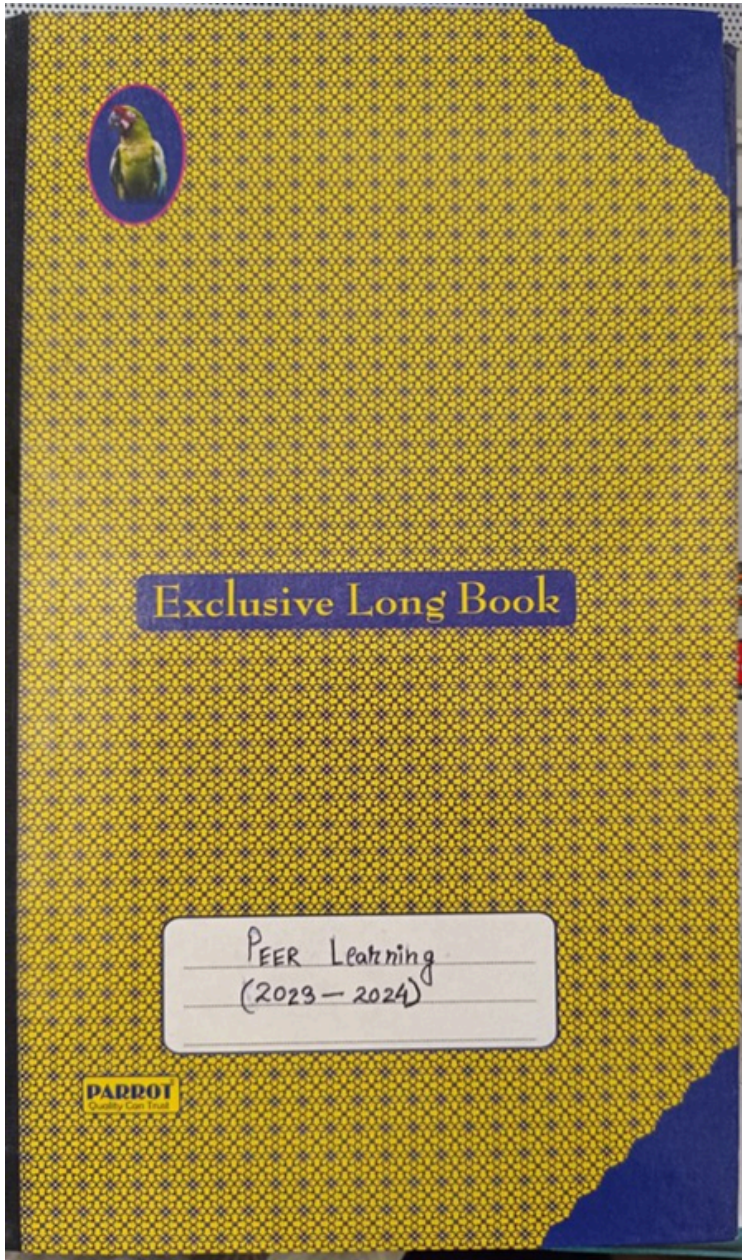
