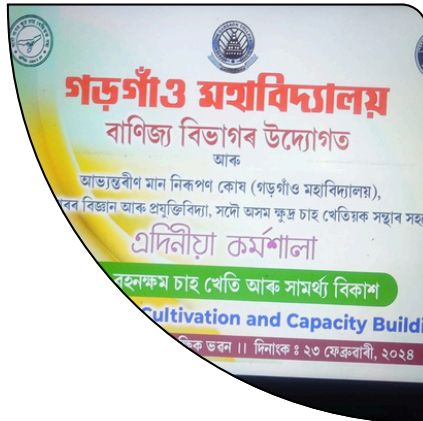

They were trained in House spawn generation, layering and spawning and controlling humidity and temperature requirements that are crucial.

The objective of the hands-on training on mushroom cultivation was to provide participants especially the students with practical skills and knowledge in the cultivation of mushrooms. Through a combination of theoretical sessions and hands-on practice, participants were expected to gain proficiency in the technique of handling spawns and the environment required for mushroom cultivation.
