Infrastructure

Sanchay Aru Rindan Somobai Samiti (SARSS)

Members of the teaching and non teaching staff of the college can become members of SARSS, a credit cooperative society of the college which is registered under Assam Cooperative Society Act, 2007. The society extends financial support to its members by providing loans to its members at reasonable rates of interest. The monthly contributions of the members are deducted from the monthly salary and deposited in their account.



Pension benefits

The institution being a government aided college, its employees get the benefit of pension. Under the old pension scheme, Employees Provident Fund (EPF) is a Retirement benefit Scheme provided by the government for the benefit of its employees. Employees under the New Pension System, the employees get the benefit of National Pension Scheme.

Maintenance of cleanliness and hygiene

The college appoints staff for maintaining cleanliness of the classrooms, staff room, campus etc. in order to provide a clean and hygienic environment to its staff.

Felicitation

The college felicitates Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff every year on foundation day for their outstanding contribution in research, administrative work, sports and other achievements.

Financial Support

The Gargaon College Teachers' Unit tries to provide financial aid to the staff in times of emergency or need such as illness etc.

Medical Assistance

As part of its health care facility, the college has a medical room or first aid centre for the staff and students and two doctors are on call to attend to any need of medical. In Covid 19 pandemic situation, mass covid testing along with immunity test was undertaken with the support of the office of the SDO. The institution also provided the facility of vaccination especially for its employees during the pandemic.

Health Awareness & Sanitation

Health Check-up camps, mental health awareness programmes etc. are conducted by the College from time-to-time. The Yoga Centre has been conducting various workshops related to yoga for the health and well-being of the college fraternity as well as the neighbouring community.
