About the TCS YEP Program:

Rural and under-privileged graduate youth from socially and economically marginalized families need a stepping-stone to stand at par in the job market. Lack of opportunities, exposure, communication skills, confidence and technical knowledge cannot be allowed to chain them to their fate. Youth Employment Program responds to this need of youth and sets them free and equal to acquire meaningful jobs in the industry.

Objectives:

- Enhance employability of rural youth from socially and economically marginalized communities, thereby promoting inclusive growth.
- Provide the beneficiaries with exposure to industry needs and make them eligible to take up employment in the corporate sector, government, and other MSMEs.
- Ensure continuous availability of talent pool for the industry and increase diversity & gender parity.

Training Details:

 The training will be of 100 hours, covering 100 hours, standard modules prepared by TCS on Business skills, Communication

- Skills, Quantitative Aptitude, Logical Reasoning, Computers, Interview Skills, Resume Writing to name a few.
- This would be followed by trainings on specific domains. Additionally, trainees will also be guided to take up Free Self-Learning Courses such as those offered by TCS iON portal.
- Cost of Training: Free.
- Prerequisites to commence the Program:
 - 1) Training Batch Count:
 - a) A minimum of 50 students per batch in digital mode of training.
 - 2) Training Batch Composition:
 - a) Socially Weaker Section: 40% of the Batch (SC/ST)
 - b) Economically Weaker Section: Annual Family Income less than Rs 6, 00,000 per annum.

Eligible Batch:

- a) Year of Degree Passing: 2021, 2022, 2023.
- b) Only students from regular mode are eligible.
- Training Duration: Digital Batch: 45-50 Working Days, 2 Hours/Day, Mon-Saturday.
- Post Training Certification: Trainees will receive a digital certificate of participation and completion from TCS which will stand as a testimony and accreditation of their employability prospects in the corporate world.

Placement:

 All candidates get exposure to multiple opportunities while in training and on completion of training. The candidates are also registered with the National Career



Services portal under the Ministry of Labour and Employment of the Government of India, to enable their access to wide variety of employers and vacancies posted therein. The candidates also participate in the National Qualifier Tests organized by TCS, the scores of which are accepted by wide variety of industries.

- Direct recruitment to positions within TCS.
- Application to other companies (through TCS iON, NCS, job portals etc).
- Direct link with employers and placement agencies.
- Mentoring for candidates with other career aspirations.
