PROCESS OF AVAILING THE AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIPS/MEDALS:

• For providing merit scholarships, various departments and the faculty members prepare the list of best students with highest grades from Departments as well as the College to confer Philanthropic and Institutional Awards.



- In the case of Academic Excellence Prizes, the College Award & Scholarship Committee generates the list of rank holders using the result sheet from Dibrugarh University. A notice inviting applications from students wishing to avail of this facility is posted on the college notice board.
- In the case of government scholarships, a notice, seeking applications from students who want to avail of the governmental scholarship facility is put on the college notice board. Students are required to fill out the prescribed form and submit it along with required documents such as income certificate, marksheet of last examination, bank account details, ID proof etc. And this is carried out by the Office staff engaged in Scholarship work.
- Various departments also provide financial assistance to economically disadvantaged students to support their participation in various academic and extracurricular activities.


