g) Brief report of the program (100-250 words):

Gargaon College organized an online workshop on issues related to gender sensitization. The program is organized by Women Cell (GCTU), in association with IQAC, Gargaon College and Department of Chemistry, Gargaon College, Sivasagar, Assam. It was coordinated by Dr. Pakiza Begum, Assistant Secretary, Women Cell (GCTU), Gargaon College. There have been two sessions in the workshop presided by Ms. Pimily Langthasa, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, Gargaon College and Ms. Upama Saikia, Guest Lecturer, Department of Political Science, Gargaon College. The first speaker gave talk on the topic "Women: A key differentiator towards gender equality" where discussed on topics like gender equity and equality,

gender roles and identity, gender policies and challenges towards achieving gender equality. She said that Gender sensitization plays a very role in achieving gender equality; how it plays a role in dismantling of systemic gender biases and sexism. She further added that evaluation of all public service policies, programs and activities can be done so that the gender sensitive public services are effective in its planning, implementation and monitoring reforms.

The second speaker's talk was on Laws and Practicalities: Understanding Women Rights in India. She emphasized on the constitutional rights regarding women and focus on some recent examples of some amendments of Acts regarding women in India. She further discussed various schemes of Assam government which has been adopted for the protection and promotion of women rights. Although on certain grounds, the scenario is different which could be understood from recent reports of increasing crime against women in India. The speaker focused that the need of the hour is to change people's mind-set with the changing transformation from the rights to protection and from discrimination to dignity and respect.

h) Rationality of the program

Gender inequalities are learned through education at various levels including the family, school, religions, society and the wider community level. Through such programs the students can form their own judgement on issues like-

- Having a girl's body does not teach one to do household work or care for others.
- Having a boy's body does not ensure that they will be fearless, intelligent and strong
- These qualities are learnt and taught to us at different stages in our lives within the family, schools, community, and so on.
- It is one's upbringing that determines how one grows, what one becomes.
- To learn about the idea of "stereotypes" and consider whether gender stereotypes are fair or unfair.
- To enable them to understand how it feels to not conform to socially defined gender norms.







Gargaon College Joins Hands to Celebrate National Girl Child Day

Khairuddin Ahmed, Sibsagar, Jan 25: National Girl Child Day was observed on 24th January, 2023 at the premises of Gargaon College by the Department of Statistics and Women Cell, Gargaon College Teacher's Unit in association with IQAC, Gargaon College and 11 Assam Girls (I) Coy NCC, Gargaon College. Dr Ranjana Gogoi, head and Associate Professor of the department of Statistics while putting across the objectives and significance of the program explained how National Girl Child Day was first initiated in 2008 by the Ministry of Women and Child Development to draw attention to the inequalities faced by the girl child and to create awareness regarding her rights including the importance of education, health, and nutrition. Significantly, the date also marks the day in 1966 that Late Indira Gandhi took over as the first woman Prime Minister of India.

Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, Principal of Gargaon College and noted academician, in an insightful and thought-provoking address delineated the bleak social scenario where girls continue to face prejudice, inequality and abuse despite two decades of the twenty first century having elapsed and the breakthroughs made in science and other fields. 






REPORT

The International Women's Day was celebrated at Gargaon College on 8th March, 2023. The purpose of celebrating Women's Day is – To raise awareness about the status and dignity of women among the students.

UNESCO states, "International Women's Day is an occasion to celebrate the progress made towards achieving gender equality and women's empowerment but also to critically reflect on those accomplishments and strive for a greater momentum towards gender equality worldwide. It is a day to recognize the extraordinary acts of women and to stand together, as a united force, to advance gender equality around the world."

The United Nations has highlighted the need for inclusive technology and digital education. It plans to have discussions on the role of all stakeholders in improving access to digital tools. With the IWD's origins linked to women workers' movements, it is important to note that

women's lack of access to technology and digital tools makes them less likely to be a part of the wider domains of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics – collectively termed the STEM fields.

The UN theme for this year's International Women's Day is "DigitALL: Innovation and technology for gender equality". This theme is aligned with the priority theme for the upcoming 67th Session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW-67), "Innovation and technological change, and education in the digital age for achieving gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls".

At the outset of program Principal of Gargaon College, Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta, gave a speech on Women's Day. In his talk, he emphasized that gender equality and empowerment is essential to drive transformative change, find innovative solutions to help women and girls unleash their human capital and become leaders, entrepreneurs, and agents of change for green, resilient, and inclusive development. Engaging women is key to development, including climate action. Women's economic empowerment, in conjunction with girls' education, family planning, reproductive and sexual health, and reduced child marriage, can facilitate the transition to low-carbon economies, help improve resource use, and assist in lowering environmental damage and land fragmentation, as well as increase resilience. He urged upon to accelerate gender equality and empowerment today for a more sustainable tomorrow!

It also provides opportunity to engage a diverse audience and contribute to the ongoing efforts to maintain a robust and safe blood supply worldwide.

w) Brief report of the program (100-250 words)

Gargaon College celebrated World Blood Donor Day on 14th June, 2023 to raise awareness about the importance of safe blood donation voluntarily. To commemorate World Blood Donors Day, an online awareness programme was organized by 11 Assam Girls (I) Coy NCC, 49 Assam Naval Unit NCC, IQAC, NSS and Women Cell (GCTU). The resource person of the programme was Dr. Alakhya Baruah, MD (AM), Medical Practitioner, a renowned theatre personality and Vice Chairman of Assam State Film Finance and Development Corporation.

The programme was inaugurated by renowned academician and Principal of Gargaon College, Dr. Sabyasachi Mahanta. In his inaugural address, Dr. Mahanta spoke on the importance of donating blood as blood is the most precious gift that anyone can give to another person – the gift of life. He narrated how as an active member of Red Cross Society; he has been donating blood countless times. Talking about the importance of the day, he gave an insight on the theme of this year "Give Blood, Give Plasma, Share Life, Share Often" which focuses on patients requiring life-long transfusion support and underlines the role every single person can play, by giving the valuable gift of blood or plasma. He urged people to stay away from the myths related to blood donation and explained how giving blood may help our body's detoxing potential. He encouraged the people to donate blood and contribute to the well being of not only the family, but also of the society as a whole.

The resource person, Dr. Alakhya Baruah explained how transfusing or donating blood or its components to the needy person has become very important part of humanity in the modern health care system. Accentuating the importance of blood donation, he talked about Eligibility Criteria for Blood Donation: age should between 18 and 60 years, haemoglobin not less than 12.5 g/Dl, pulse - between 50 and 100/minute with no irregularities, Blood Pressure -Systolic 100-180 mm Hg and Diastolic 50 - 100 mm Hg, Temperature - Normal (oral temperature not exceeding 37.5°C and body weight - not less than 50 kg. In some medical conditions like cancer, HIV, Hepatitis B and C, patients can donate only after being cured completely. Tattooed people can donate after six months as they might have some kind of infection from the needle. He emphasized that people with high Hb count (more than 16 g/Dl) should clinically control blood thickness as it could cause some serious diseases like

heart attack or stroke, and blood cancers (such as lymphomas or leukaemia). They should therefore seek proper medical help, he added. For those with lower blood count, he stressed the need to consume iron rich food. He said that during a regular donation, one can give around 470 ml of whole blood and our body replaces this volume within 24 to 48 hours, and replenishes red blood cells in 10 to 12 weeks. He further emphasized that one should donate blood at least 2-3 times a year since it can help maintain a healthy heart and overall good health.

The significant outcomes were highlighted towards the end of the webinar with a Vote of Thanks, delivered by CTO, NCC, 11 Assam Girls Coy (I), Ms. Pimily Langhtasa. The webinar, moderated by Dr. Raktim Patar, CTO, 49 Assam Naval, concluded with a thought-provoking question and answer session where the expert answered the queries of the participants. The programme was attended by faculty, students and NCC Cadets of Gargaon College.

11. Brief report of the program:

A National Webinar on "End Child Labor Today" was jointly organized by the Department of Zoology, Department of Assamese, Women Cell (GCTU), IQAC and 11 Assam Girls (I) Coy NCC, Gargaon College on 12th June, 2023 to celebrate World Day Against Child Labor. The webinar held in blended mode, was inaugurated by Dr. Rina Handique, Vice-Principal, Gargaon College and Head, Department of Zoology, Gargaon College.
