Feedback Committee Report 2021- 2022

The Department has developed a feedback mechanism for obtaining feedback from the various stakeholders through a structured rating-based feedback form. Feedback from Stakeholders

The department collects feedback from stakeholders – students, alumni,teachers, and parents through a structured rating-based feedback form. It is done by the Feedback Committee of the Department. They collect and analyze the feedback received and make suggestions during the departmental meetings, to take appropriate action for improvement. In past, it was collected manually, but now it has been collected online

Objective:

The objective of this practice is to correctly measure the impact of all the efforts taken by the departments at all levels on the stakeholders. The departments want the benefits to reach the stakeholders. This feedback is collected and trends are generated through statistical analysis. Based on the opinions of the stakeholders, further action is taken by the Feedback Committee of the Department.

Methodology:

A. Feedback persons

- 1. Feedback on the curriculum is collected from the stakeholders by uploading the Feedback Forms through Google Forms. It is collected online and brought to the Feedback Committee of the Department. for its analysis. The Statistical data is handed over to the Feedback Committee. Further suggestions are incorporated by departments.
- 2. Alumni Feedback is collected online. The filled-in forms are sent for further action. The subsequent action is similar to the other forms.
- 3. The teachers of the department also give their feedback, which is forwarded to the Feedback Committee for further action.

- 4. The feedback committee collects inputs and suggestions from the authorities. The decisions taken by the authorities are forwarded for action to be initiated.
- 5. To provide parents the opportunity to comment on the quality of their ward's learning experience, as required in preparation for and as part of the review process. To assess the success of academic provision about the expectations of both the parents and the students. To provide feedback to the faculties in order to improve the delivery and/or content of the curriculum.









Conclusion

The first question was asked whether the courses provided in the Economics department of Gargaon College was useful in real life. The findings show that about 88% of the respondents found it is useful and marked it between 'good' to 'excellent' in the scale. It is also observed that around 96% added to the view that the Courses in the programme are appropriate, relevant and help them to go for higher studies and career planning. With regard to the updating of the syllabus, 100% of the respondents found it excellent and satisfactory.

When opinions were asked about teachers' subject knowledge, about 50% of the respondents have confidently agreed with 'excellent' in the scale of measurement and only 4% mentioned 'not satisfactory'. It is also observed that 92% respondents confidently shared the view that the teachers have good communication style and teaching methodology. Also, 66% of the respondents suggested that the Continuous Internal Assessment is an instrument of continuous learning and progress for students.

The respondents also gave their feedback about mentoring facilities of the college. 











Count of Teacher's punctuality in the class




Count of Teacher completed syllabus on time








