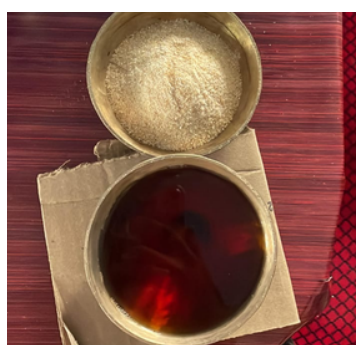


SHOWCASE AND AWARENESS OF INDIGENOUS FOOD OF NORTH-EAST INDIA
