

Grievance Redressal Report

Period: 2019 - 2024

Background

The Gargaon College has developed a platform for different stakeholders of the institution to seek redressal of their grievances as a part of its initiatives for quality improvement towards its mission of achieving excellence in higher education. The grievances can be filed either in online or offline mode.

A grievance committee is designated with the role of receiving the grievances/complaints and initiating corrective actions. Accordingly, once the grievance has been submitted, the committee takes up the issue. Based on the type of grievances received which include teaching/learning, library, hostels, administration, infrastructure, sports and other facilities, the committee takes a final resolution to solve the issues to the extent possible.



In case of minor grievances, the grievance is addressed by the competent authority within a period of 3-5 working days whereas major grievances take nearly 30 days or more. Stakeholders can provide their feedback on the quality of resolution of a grievance through "Satisfied" / "Dissatisfied" option. If they are dissatisfied with the grievance resolution, same can be escalated to the higher authority.


Grievance Redressal Committee

These main objectives of the Committee are enlisted below:

- The Committee is formed in order to keep a healthy working atmosphere amongst staff, students and parents.
- The Committee helps Students to record their complaints and solve their problems related to academics, resources, personal grievances freely and honestly without any fear of victimization.
- To keep the dignity of the college high by ensuring a conflict-free atmosphere in the College by promoting student-teacher relationships.
- To ensure effective solutions to the students' open-minded approach.
- To develop integrity within students' community and encourage the students
 of the College to respect each other and be patient whenever any occasion of
 conflict arises.
- To prevent students from agitating with other students, teachers and College administration.
- Prevention of ragging in any form in and outside the college. Any violation of ragging and disciplinary rules should be urgently brought to the notice of the principal. Ragging complaints will be handled as per ragging rules.
- Resolve woman harassment complaints as per government guidelines by respective section.
- Students can complain about matters related to of sanitation, preparation of food in the canteen and hostel, canteen services and hygiene, cleanliness in classroom & college campus, victimization by teachers, examination related matters, financial matters related to dues and payments etc.

Methodology for Grievance Redressal

For Grievances Redressal, a mechanism is adopted which begins with the collection of grievances, followed by a step-by-step procedure of resolving the issue. The overall mechanism is highlighted in the flow chart below:



Collection of grievances:

The grievances are collected either in online or in offline mode. In the online mode of grievance collection, a Google Form is prepared for collecting grievances which is uploaded in the Grievance Portal of the official website of the Institute. In the offline mode, the grievances are collected through hardcopies in Complaint Boxes installed in the College campus.

Methodology for Grievance Redressal

Evaluation of grievances:

The grievances collected in online or in offline mode are then transmitted to Grievance Committee for evaluation. The Committe sits once in a month and discusses the grievances received and prepare a strategy for a follow up action. The head of the Institution takes the final resolution on the decisions and instructs the committee to initiates the actions to resolve the issues.

Action & feedback:

Once a resolution is taken, the committee endeavors to accomplish the tasks at the earliest possible. For minor grievances it takes a time period of 2-3 days whereas in case of major grievances it takes around 30 days or more for resolving the issue. After the issue is resolved, the committee undertakes a satisfactory survey from the stakeholders. If the stakeholders are satisfied with the grievance redressal, the Committee decides to close the issue whereas in case the stakeholder is dissatisfied, the issue is again sent to the Head of the Institution for further necessary actions.

Action taken report:

After resolving the issues, the Committee prepares an Action Taken Report highlighting the steps taken to resolve the issue and the feedback received in the satisfactory survey.





Assessment of types of online grievances


Grievance categories







Action Taken Report

In the last five years, the Grievance Committee has taken prompt initiatives and recommended various tasks towards resolving the issues and complaints received from different stakeholders. Based on the Recommendations of the Grievance Committe a number of steps have been taken by the administration towards redressal of the grievance and quality improvement as per the needs.

Some major recommendations of the Grievance Committee are:






